TO: Residents of Ebert and Town Center Metropolitan Districts (TCMD)
SUBJECT: Continuing call for applicants to serve on the Joint Landscape Committee
DATE: Until cancelled by the Ebert and TCMD Boards of Directors

The Boards of Directors of the Ebert Metropolitan District (“Ebert”) and the Town Center Metropolitan District (“Town”) are seeking knowledgeable applicants interested in serving on the Districts’ Joint Landscape Committee.

The general purpose of the Landscape Committee is to serve in an advisory role and make recommendations to the Boards of Directors regarding policies and operations related to landscaping throughout the districts and to represent the community to the Districts’ Boards, the developer of the undeveloped property within the Districts, and the Districts’ District Manager(s) (“DM”).

The District seeks knowledgeable applicants to fill the following positions on the Joint Landscape Committee:

- There are 2 positions allocated to Ebert. Residents who reside anywhere within the Ebert Metropolitan District including Town’s subdistricts within the Ebert District boundaries, may apply.
- There are 7 positions allocated to Town, consisting of:
 - Two (2) appointed Town positions, and
 - Five (5) Subdistrict positions, consisting of 1 position each, for each of the 5 Subdistricts.

Residents who reside anywhere within the Ebert Metropolitan District and that include Town’s subdistricts, may apply. Town intends to give Subdistrict position preference to persons residing within the respective Subdistrict.

Interest in serving in any of the 9 positions on the Joint Landscape Committee should be directed to the respective District’s DM. Refer to the respective District’s website for DM contact info.

The DM for the respective Board may interview an applicant to assess suitability based on the applicant’s knowledge, experience, and prior or current community engagement, and make a recommendation to the respective Board of Directors at the respective District’s Regular or Special meetings.

The respective District DM will make applicant recommendations to the respective Board. The Boards will consider applications on a continuing basis until all positions have been filled.

Applicants should be willing to serve on the Landscape Committee for a term of one-year and must demonstrate a particular interest in improving landscaping of common areas within the community with professionalism and a positive attitude.

Notice to Applicants:

- a) Incumbent committee members may continue serving successive terms at the discretion of the respective Board.
- b) The respective Board reserves the right to change committee members at any time, with or without cause, at their sole discretion.

Anyone interested in serving on the Joint Landscape Committee in any of the positions identified above should submit, via email, the following information (the 'application') to the district's DM, consisting of:

- (1) a letter of interest specifying which position desired: Ebert, Town, Subdistrict 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5
- (2) applicant's physical address
- (3) number of years owning property within the District/Subdistricts and any relevant community engagement activities within the District or at prior addresses
- (4) a description of relevant experience and knowledge about special districts and/or landscaping
- (5) a general biographical statement

The DM of each district will keep applications on file for the purpose of canvassing the pool of 'prior' non-selected applicants on the occasion that committee vacancies may occur.
